

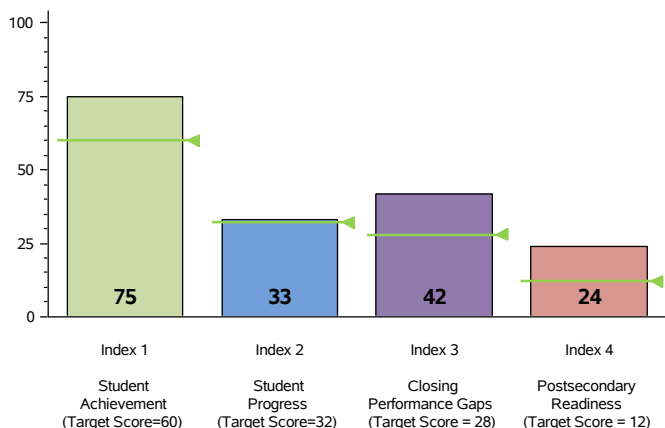

### 2017 Performance Index
